ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Deadline: February 24, 2017, 12:00 pm (noon) ET

Abstracts that do not meet all of the specifications listed below will be automatically rejected:

- An individual may be the presenting author on a maximum of two abstracts.
- There can be no more than 10 authors per abstract.
- Abstracts must be submitted at http://bit.ly/PosterCEHN2017. No emailed, mailed, or faxed submissions will be accepted. *Character limits apply*.
- Trade or brand names may not be used in abstract titles and are limited to one reference within the body.
- Supplemental information, such as references, tables, figures or any other graphics are not permitted, and must not be emailed, mailed, or faxed.
- Case reports will not be considered.

Abstracts will not be accepted for presentation if they fail to reflect acceptable scientific methodology, if the data or statistical analyses do not justify the conclusions, if they lack sufficient scientific or clinical merit, or if no data are included. All abstracts are peer-reviewed; notice of acceptance will be sent to the contact author via email before February 28, 2017.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION PROCESS

All abstracts must be submitted electronically, in English, via the online portal http://bit.ly/PosterCEHN2017. Online submission will open February 12, 2017.

The final deadline to submit is 12:00 pm ET on February 24, 2017; the deadline will not be extended under any circumstances.

Authors are encouraged to submit abstracts early. You will be able to revise your abstract until the close time and date of 12:00 pm (noon) ET, February 24, 2017.

Please review your work for accuracy; abstracts will be printed exactly as submitted. Due to the high number of abstracts anticipated, copyediting of your abstract will not be permitted.

In order to withdraw an abstract, the author of the abstract must provide written notification to Kristie Trousdale (kristiet@cehn.org) by March 5, 2017. No substitutions will be allowed; only withdrawals.



The CEHN 2017 Advisory Committee will offer two Junior Investigator awards for poster presenters.

Selection of award winners will be based on the novelty of the work presented, methodological rigor, clarity of presentation, and potential to influence public health or environmental policy, clinical practice, or future research.
