Eco-Healthy Child Care® partners with child care professionals to reduce environmental hazards such as poor indoor air quality, pesticides, lead & unsafe plastics found in & around child care facilities.

- Creating safer & healthier early learning environments is key to protecting the wellbeing of our nation's children & child care providers.
- Science links environmental hazards found in child care settings to allergies, asthma, developmental disabilities, & cancer.
- Children are at greater risk since their bodies are still developing & because of increased exposures due to certain behaviors (e.g. mouthing objects or crawling on the floor).

Eco-Healthy Child Care® endorsed child care facilities are featured on our **provider map**. These programs are leading the industry, & going above & beyond required child care regulations to protect the health of staff & children within their care.

Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Monitoring Initiative

Licensed child care facilities are invited to be involved in our Environmental health in Child Care, Improving Air Quality initiative. Participating facilities will receive:

- **\$1000 in mini-grant funds** for environmental health related resources at your facility (i.e. replacing harmful plastics, purchasing new cleaning supplies, HVAC tune-up).
- **FREE HEPA air filters** distributed to participating facilities that providers can keep after data collection as well as **results on indoor air quality** data collection and assistance with actionable strategies for mitigating airborne contaminants.
- Techincal assistance for Eco-Healthy Child Care® Endorsement application, fee waived.
- FREE on-line professional development with adult learning clock hours.
