This year is especially important, because we're celebrating not only the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Child Health Advocate Awards, but also the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Children's Environmental Health Day.

#### This work matters because:

- An estimated 34% of children's chronic illnesses and developmental problems are caused by environmental factors.
- 1 in 4 US children aged 2-8 have a chronic health condition.
- Globally, children are estimated to bear 88% of the burden of disease due to climate change.
- These harms disproportionately affect Black, Latino/a, and Indigenous/Tribal children and children from families with lower wealth due to economic inequalities and environmental racism.

## Tenth Anniversary of Children's Environmental Health Day

October 9, 2025 marks a decade of cross-sector work toward safer, healthier environments for children through Children's Environmental Health Day (CEH Day). To celebrate and galvanize the movement, CEHN is hosting a nationwide campaign to build grassroots advocacy capacity, center community and youth stories, and uplift a unified, hopeful movement in the face of protective policy rollbacks, cuts to critical programs and workforce, and growing public health threats.

## Child Health Champion Trainings and advocate support

This campaign includes a summer advocacy training series and individualized advocacy support for child health advocates. These free 75-minute trainings are designed to help advocates across all sectors—public health, early childhood, education, environmental justice, caregiving, and youth—build power, tell our stories, and take meaningful action together.

#### Participants learn how to:

- · Schedule and prepare for meetings with our elected officials
- Use storytelling to shift hearts and minds
- Frame children's environmental health as a unifying, nonpartisan issue
- Navigate potentially challenging spaces with integrity and clarity
- Leverage political and media advocacy to push for positive change as a united movement for children's environmental health

CEHN has already offered four sessions (including youth & family content in partnership with Mom Clean Air Force and a session for researchers in partnership with Emory University). Each session was also available with simultaneous Spanish transcription.

Between now and October 9, participants are receiving hands-on support to request local and state proclamations, craft their own advocacy story, deliver it to press and decision-makers effectively, and navigate the logistics of advocacy.

# Mentorship, support, and community-building for youth & early career professionals

Sponsorship helps facilitate CEHN's efforts to mentor and support youth and early career children's environmental health professionals.

CEHN's internship, fellowship, and volunteer programs continue to grow in size and strength each year. CEHN continues to evolve our programs, incorporating feedback from our network and taking our current political and economic reality into account.

This year, in addition to our existing youth and early career programs, CEHN is launching an exiting new program in response to requests from our youth leaders. This fall, we will being hosting bi-monthly virtual engagement calls focused on youth connected to CEHN, including current and past interns, fellows, and volunteers, NOW Youth awardees and nominees, and other youth leaders. These calls are intended to cultivate community among young advocates, facilitate the sharing of information and resources, and provide access to mentors in the field.

Finally, CEHN encourages children, youth, and early career professionals to join us at the annual awards

event at no cost or a deeply reduced cost. The event is intentionally designed with an emphasis on community building and intergenerational exchange.



#### Fireside chat speaker series

Sponsorship also allows CEHN to enrich our advocacy training campaign with a series of fireside chats, featuring this year's Child Health Advocate and NOW Youth Leadership Awardees. This series of short seminars will be made into short form video and shared widely on social media, helping to inspire and galvanize the children's environmental health movement.



#### **Annual Awards Celebration**

Finally, sponsorship make our annual in person awards celebration possible. **The 20th Annual Child Health Advocate & 13th Annual NOW Youth Leadership Awards** honor outstanding advocates for their leadership on behalf of children's environmental health, equity, and climate action and justice.

We look forward to gathering child health advocates at Woodend Sanctuary in Chevy Chase, Maryland, to celebrate Children's Environmental Health Day and honor our 2025 Awardees with an in-person reception on Thursday, October 9, 2025. This is a festive and high-energy event, open to all members of the children's environmental health community.

This soiree is designed to honor our celebrants while encouraging cross-pollination and collaboration within the field, especially for early-career professionals, students, and youth. The evening will begin with ample networking time, cocktails, and hors d'oeuvres. The subsequent award presentation and brief inspiring remarks will re-energize attendees to continue their work to protect children's health and the environment.


